EDUCATION PROGRAMS

Children First - (941) 953 - 3877

- Early Head Start
 - Early Head Start promotes healthy prenatal outcomes, enhances the development of infants and toddlers (from birth to three years of age) and supports family well-being
- Head Start
 - Serves children from three to five years old and their families, the Children First Head Start program focuses on Kindergarten readiness. Our team of highly qualified teachers and dedicated volunteers help young students to gain the cognitive, social and emotional skills needed to succeed in Kindergarten and beyond.
- RISE
 - A partnership between Children First and Take Stock in Children Sarasota County Inc., a statewide mentoring and college scholarship program. RISE provides support to low-income families with students in grades K-5 through a two part approach. One-on-one literacy support for each child instills a love of reading and creates caring relationships between child and mentor, and work with families promotes parent engagement and investment in students' education.

DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENINGS

Early Steps - (941) 487-5400

Florida's early intervention system that offers services to eligible infants and toddlers, age birth to 36 months, who have or are at-risk for developmental disabilities or delays.
